Earned Awards (First Semester, Second Semester, or All-year Awards)

- A Honor Roll
- B Honor Roll
- Outstanding Citizenship
- Perfect Attendance

- President's gold award A Honor Roll both semesters
- President's silver award B Honor Roll both semesters, or A/B combination

Note: At year end B Honor Roll 1st Sem + A Honor Roll 2nd Sem = President's silver and 2nd Sem A Honor Roll
 A Honor Roll 1st Sem + B Honor Roll 2nd Sem = President's silver and 2nd Sem B Honor Roll

Special Awards

Special awards may only be given in the following two categories: Most Academic Improvement or Exemplary Achievement in a field, such as art or music. The exemplary achievement award is given for *significantly higher* achievement than almost all students on that grade level.

Awards Criterion

A and B Honor Roll is calculated on semester grades in the following subjects only: Bible/Memory, Reading, Phonics, Language, Math, Spelling, History/Geography, Science/Health, Writing/Penmanship (Primary grades have fewer subjects – but use subjects listed only)

Note: A grade of D+ or below in any subject disqualifies a student for an Honor Roll award.

- A Honor Roll is awarded to a student with a GPA of 3.5 and above
- B Honor Roll is awarded to a student with a GPA of 2.7 – 3.4

Outstanding Citizenship

- K No office visits. No more than 3 times-out per week. Good overall behavior.
- 1st & 2nd No more than 10 tickets pulled over the entire semester.
- 3rd – 6th No tickets pulled over the entire semester. No behavior referrals. No missed homework

Perfect Attendance means no absences or tardies over the semester. The award is only given to those who have a perfect attendance record.

Honor Roll Computation Standard

The 4-point GPA scale, including “+” and “-” grades, is used to determine grade points (Gd. Pts.) for each subject.

Grade points are summed in the subjects listed above using the scale shown. That number is divided by the number of subjects, then round up to the nearest GPA. If the GPA is 2.7 or above (with no D's) the student earns and Honor Roll award.

Example: Susie Smith has semester grades in subjects listed of C-, B-, C+, B, C, B+, A
 Her grade points are 1.7, 2.7, 2.4, 3.0, 2.0, 3.4, 4.0 Total grade points = 19.2
 19.2 grade points divided by 7 subjects equals a 2.74 GPA.
Even though she has two C grades she earns a B Honor Roll award because her GPA is above 2.7 (B-.)
